

Ceramic twist

"Ruski and Ruski twist are two suspension lamps designed by Italy-based designer Enrico Zanolla for Toronto based company Viso inc, presented during the light-building 2012 in Frankfurt. The lamps are produced entirely in ceramic, both available in white or black glazing, silver or gold metallic."
